- 3 FOR the purpose of specifying that a marriage between two consenting adults is valid
- 4 in the State; altering the definition of a "foreign marriage"; and generally
- 5 relating to the validity of marriages in the State.

- 11 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
- 12 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:
- 13 Article Family Law
- 14 2-201.
- 15 (A) Only a marriage between [a man and a woman] TWO CONSENTING
- 16 ADULTS is valid in this State.
- 17 (B) THIS SECTION DOES NOT INVALIDATE ANY OTHER SECTIONS IN THIS
- 18 TITLE.
- 19 2-502.
- 20 (a) In this section, "foreign marriage" means a marriage ceremony:
- 21 (1) performed outside this State; [and]
- 22 (2) BETWEEN TWO CONSENTING ADULTS; AND
- 23 [(2)] (3) in which [1] ONE or both of the parties were or are citizens of
- 24 this State.

- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 2 October 1, 1998.
