A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 State Employees - District Court Employees

- 3 FOR the purpose of removing certain clerical, administrative, and full-time constable
- 4 positions in the District Court of Maryland from the State Personnel
- 5 Management System; providing that certain clerical, administrative, and
- 6 constabular employees of the District Court are in the personnel system of the
- 7 judicial branch; repealing a certain provision of law requiring that the salary of
- 8 certain commissioners be set by the Secretary of Budget and Management;
- 9 making a stylistic change; providing that this Act is not intended to affect
- 10 certain benefits of employees transferred under this Act and that the employees
- shall be transferred without any diminution of compensation or benefits; and generally relating to employees of the District Court of Maryland.

- 23 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
- 24 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:
- 25 Article Courts and Judicial Proceedings
- 26 2-601.
- 27 (b) Except as [provided in § 2-602 of this subtitle or] otherwise PROVIDED by
- 28 law, the clerical, administrative, and constabular employees of the District Court

1 shall be appointed by the Chief Judge of the District Court on the recommendation of 2 the administrative judge for the district [and shall be in the skilled service, with the 3 exception of special appointments, in the State Personnel Management System] AND 4 SHALL BE IN THE PERSONNEL SYSTEM OF THE JUDICIAL BRANCH. 5 2-604. 6 Constables may serve either full time or part time. Full-time constables (b) 7 [are in the skilled service, with the exception of special appointments, in the State 8 Personnel Management System and shall be paid on the same salary scale as that 9 set by the Secretary of Budget and Management pursuant to § 2-309(d) of this article 10 for full-time deputy sheriffs in Baltimore City. Part-time constables [are not in the 11 State Personnel Management System, and are paid the compensation prescribed by 12 the General Assembly, and serve at the pleasure of the Chief Judge of the District 13 Court. 14 2-607. Commissioners shall be adult residents of the counties in which they 15 (b) (1) 16 serve, but they need not be lawyers. The salary of commissioners shall be set by the Secretary of Budget 17 [(2)]18 and Management. 19 (3)] (2) Each commissioner shall hold office at the pleasure of the Chief 20 Judge of the District Court, and has the powers and duties prescribed by law. Except without additional compensation, unless otherwise fixed 21 [(4)](3) 22 by law, an employee of the District Court, who is an adult, may be granted, in the 23 same manner, commissioner powers and duties in the county where [he] THE 24 EMPLOYEE is employed. 25 **Article - State Personnel and Pensions** 26 6-303. 27 All positions in the Judicial Branch of State government are excluded from the 28 State Personnel Management System except[: the positions in the District Court of Maryland that are listed in § (1) 30 6-401(b) of this title; or 31 (2)] as otherwise provided by law. 32 6-401.

Except as provided in this title or otherwise by law, all positions in the

- 1 [(b)]Except as otherwise provided by law, the following positions in the Judicial 2 Branch of State government are in the skilled service: (1) clerical and administrative positions in the District Court of 4 Maryland; and 5 full-time constables in the District Court of Maryland. (2) 6 (c)] (B) The skilled service includes any other position that is specified by law 7 to be in the skilled service. 8 9-202. 9 (a) Except as provided in subsection (b) of this section, this subtitle applies 10 to[: 11 (1)all employees of all units in the Executive Branch of State 12 government, including any unit with an independent personnel system[; and 13 all employees of the District Court of Maryland who are in the State 14 Personnel Management System]. 15 9-801. Except as provided in subsection (b) of this section, this subtitle applies 16 (a) 17 to[: 18 all employees, including temporary employees, of all units in the (1)19 Executive Branch of State government, including any unit with an independent 20 personnel system[; and 21 all employees of the District Court of Maryland who are in the State 22 Personnel Management System]. 23 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act is not intended to 24 affect the benefits allowed from time to time under the State Employee and Retiree 25 Health and Welfare Benefits Program or the State Retirement and Pension System 26 for any employee transferred from the State Personnel Management System under
- 27 this Act. These employees shall not lose any compensation solely as a result of the
- 28 transfer, nor lose any accumulated leave, leave accrual rates, or other benefits.
- 29 SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 30 July 1, 1998.
