(C) (1) THIS SUBSECTION APPLIES TO A CONTRACT GOVERNED BY § 12-110 11 OF THE STATE FINANCE AND PROCUREMENT ARTICLE. 12 AN INDIVIDUAL WHO HAS MANAGEMENT RESPONSIBILITIES WITHIN (2) 13 A UNIT OF STATE GOVERNMENT MAY NOT, FOR A PERIOD OF 1 YEAR FROM THE 14 TERMINATION OF STATE EMPLOYMENT, ACCEPT EMPLOYMENT FROM A PERSON 15 WHO IS AWARDED A CONTRACT UNDER § 12-110 OF THE STATE FINANCE AND 16 PROCUREMENT ARTICLE TO PERFORM SERVICES THAT WERE FORMERLY 17 PERFORMED BY THE UNIT THAT EMPLOYED THE INDIVIDUAL.
