BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF 15 16 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows: 17 **Article - Family Law** 18 8-205. Subject to the provisions of PARAGRAPH (2) OF THIS SUBSECTION 19 20 AND subsection (b) of this section, after the court determines which property is 21 marital property, and the value of the marital property, the court may transfer 22 ownership of an interest in a pension, retirement, profit sharing, or deferred 23 compensation plan from 1 party to either or both parties, grant a monetary award, or 24 both, as an adjustment of the equities and rights of the parties concerning marital 25 property, whether or not alimony is awarded. 26 THE COURT MAY NOT TRANSFER MORE THAN ONE-HALF OF (2) (I) 27 THE OWNERSHIP INTEREST IN A PENSION, RETIREMENT, PROFIT SHARING, OR

28 DEFERRED COMPENSATION PLAN EARNED DURING THE PERIOD OF THE MARRIAGE
