3 FOR the purpose of requiring excess motor vehicle liability coverage to indemnify, up
4 to a certain amount, certain individuals who are liable to certain other
5 individuals under certain circumstances; and generally relating to excess motor
6 vehicle liability coverage.

12 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
13 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

14 **Article - Insurance**

15 19-502.

16 (b) (1) [NEITHER]SUBJECT TO THE PROVISIONS OF PARAGRAPH (2) OF THIS
17 SUBSECTION, NEITHER this subtitle nor Title 17 of the Transportation Article
18 prevents an insurer from issuing, selling, or delivering motor vehicle liability
19 insurance policies that provide liability coverage in excess of the requirements of the
20 Maryland Vehicle Law.

21 (2) MOTOR VEHICLE LIABILITY COVERAGE IN EXCESS OF THE
22 REQUIREMENTS OF THE MARYLAND VEHICLE LAW SHALL INDEMNIFY, UP TO THE
23 AMOUNT OF THE EXCESS COVERAGE, AN INSURED OR OTHER COVERED INDIVIDUAL
24 WHO IS LIABLE TO AN INJURED HOUSEHOLD FAMILY MEMBER.

25 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
26 October 1, 1998.
