	WHEREAS, The General Assembly enacted the Maryland Revised Uniform Partnership Act (Chapter 654 of the Acts of 1997), as drafted by the National Conference of Commissioners of Uniform State Laws; and
18	WHEREAS, The revised law provides that a partnership formed before the revision's effective date of July 1, 1998 shall continue to operate under the provisions of the old law until the end of the year 2002, unless the partnership chooses to come under the revised law; and
	WHEREAS, Chapter 654 repealed the text of the old law from the Annotated Code, which may result in confusion for those partnerships that will remain under the old law prior to the end of 2002; and
25	WHEREAS, The intent of this Act is to recodify the old Uniform Partnership Act, adjacent to the new Maryland Revised Uniform Partnership Act, solely for the purpose of clarifying the existence, until 2002, of two distinct bodies of law that govern partnerships in the State; and

With respect to liabilities of the partnership arising after such election, the provisions of this title relating to the liability of the partnership's partners to third parties, other than those provisions dealing with registered limited liability partnerships, apply to limit those partners' liability to a third party who had done business with the partnership within 1 year prior to the partnership's election to be governed by this title, only if the third party knows or has received a notification of the partnership's election to be governed by
