CHAPTER _____

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Dorchester County - State's Attorney - Salary**

3 FOR the purpose of altering the salary of the State's Attorney for Dorchester County;
4 providing that this Act does not affect the salary or compensation of the
5 incumbent or any future State's Attorney for Dorchester County during the term
6 of office of the State's Attorney; and generally relating to the salary of the State's
7 Attorney for Dorchester County.

13 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
14 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

3 (j) (1) In Dorchester County, the State's Attorney's salary shall be ~~{75~~ 80
4 percent of the salary of a judge of the District Court of Maryland} \$75,000.

5 ~~SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That, pursuant to Article III,~~
6 ~~Section 35 of the Constitution of Maryland, this Act may not be construed to extend or~~
7 ~~apply to the salary or compensation of the State's Attorney for Dorchester County in~~
8 ~~office on the effective date of this Act, but the provisions of this Act concerning the~~
9 ~~salary or compensation of the State's Attorney shall take effect at the beginning of the~~
10 ~~next following term of office.~~

11 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That pursuant to Article III,
12 Section 35 of the Constitution of Maryland, this Act may not be construed to increase
13 or diminish the salary or compensation of the incumbent or any future State's Attorney
14 for Dorchester County during the term of office of the State's Attorney.

15 SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
16 October 1, 1998.
