- 13 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
- 14 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

- 3 (j) (1) In Dorchester County, the State's Attorney's salary shall be $\frac{175}{80}$ 4 percent of the salary of a judge of the District Court of Maryland \$\frac{\$75,000}{.}\$
- 5 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That, pursuant to Article III,
- 6 Section 35 of the Constitution of Maryland, this Act may not be construed to extend or
- 7 apply to the salary or compensation of the State's Attorney for Dorchester County in
- 8 office on the effective date of this Act, but the provisions of this Act concerning the
- 9 salary or compensation of the State's Attorney shall take effect at the beginning of the
- 10 next following term of office.
- 11 <u>SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED</u>, That pursuant to Article III,
- 12 Section 35 of the Constitution of Maryland, this Act may not be construed to increase
- 13 or diminish the salary or compensation of the incumbent or any future State's Attorney
- 14 for Dorchester County during the term of office of the State's Attorney.
- 15 SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
- 16 October 1, 1998.
