- 11 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
- 12 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:
- 13 Article Transportation
- 14 22-405.5.
- 15 (a) A person may not sell or offer for sale, at the point of final retail sale to the
- 16 consumer, an unsafe tire, for use on a highway, that does not meet or exceed the
- 17 requirements set forth in subsection (b) of this section or in regulations promulgated
- 18 under § 22-405(c) of this [article] SUBTITLE.
- 19 (b) A tire shall be considered unsafe if it:
- 20 (1) Has tread wear indicators and the tire is worn to the point that the
- 21 tread wear indicators are flush with the tread [at any place on the tire] IN ANY
- 22 GROOVE AT THREE LOCATIONS SPACED APPROXIMATELY EQUALLY AROUND THE
- 23 OUTSIDE OF THE TIRE:
- 24 (2) Does not have tread wear indicators and the tire is worn so that less
- 25 than 2/32 of an inch tread remains when measured in any groove at three locations
- 26 spaced approximately equally around the outside of the tire; provided that motorcycle
- 27 tires shall be allowed to be worn down to 1/32 of an inch, if measured under this
- 28 paragraph;
