- 12 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
- 13 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

14 Article 2B - Alcoholic Beverages

- 16 (c) (1) This subsection applies in the following counties:
- 17 (i) Anne Arundel County;
- 18 (ii) Baltimore City;
- 19 (iii) Baltimore County;
- 20 (iv) Carroll County;
- (v) Howard County;
- 22 (vi) Prince George's County; [and]
- 23 (VII) WICOMICO COUNTY; AND

- 1 [(vii)] (VIII) Worcester County.
- 2 (2) A board may subpoena any records or papers pertaining to a licensed 3 business or establishment.
- 4 (3) If a witness refuses to produce any records or papers so subpoenaed
- 5 the board shall report the fact to the circuit court for the county, and the court shall
- 6 proceed by attachment against the witness in all respects as if the refusal had been by
- 7 a witness summoned to appear in the court in a case pending before it.
- 8 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
- 9 October 1, 1998.
