2 Police Dogs - Liability for Harm

- 3 FOR the purpose of making a person liable for the purchase, care, and training costs

- dog used by a law enforcement agency so as to force the police dog out of service;

- 17 (A) (1) IN THIS SECTION THE FOLLOWING WORDS HAVE THE MEANINGS 18 INDICATED.
- 19 (2) "LAW ENFORCEMENT AGENCY" MEANS A GOVERNMENTAL POLICE
- 20 FORCE, SHERIFF'S DEPARTMENT, SECURITY FORCE, OR OTHER AGENCY OF THE
- 21 STATE OR A COUNTY, MUNICIPALITY, OR OTHER POLITICAL SUBDIVISION OF THE
- 22 STATE.
- 23 (3) "POLICE DOG" MEANS A DOG THAT IS REGISTERED WITH AND USED
- 24 BY A LAW ENFORCEMENT AGENCY IN THE PERFORMANCE OF ITS OFFICIAL DUTIES.
- 25 (B) A PERSON WHO, WHILE IN THE ACT OF COMMITTING A CRIME FOR WHICH
- 26 THE PERSON IS LATER CONVICTED, KILLS, MAIMS, OR OTHERWISE HARMS A POLICE
- 27 DOG USED BY A LAW ENFORCEMENT AGENCY SO AS TO FORCE THE POLICE DOG OUT

- 1 OF SERVICE IS LIABLE FOR THE PURCHASE, CARE, AND TRAINING COSTS OF A
- 2 REPLACEMENT POLICE DOG.
- 3 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
- 4 October 1, 1998.
