- 28 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
- 29 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

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Article - Health Occupations

- 3 (a) The Board shall perform any necessary preliminary investigation before
- 4 the Board refers to an investigatory body an allegation of grounds for disciplinary or
- 5 other action brought to its attention.
- 6 (c) (5) AFTER PERFORMING ANY NECESSARY PRELIMINARY

- 14 (a) Subject to the hearing provisions of § 14-405 of this subtitle, the Board, on
- 15 the affirmative vote of a majority of its full authorized membership, may reprimand
- 16 any licensee, place any licensee on probation, or suspend or revoke a license if the

- 18 (39) Intentionally misrepresents credentials for the purpose of testifying
- 19 or rendering an expert opinion in hearings or proceedings before the Board or those
- 20 otherwise delegated to the Office of Administrative Hearings; [or]
- 21 (40) Fails to keep adequate medical records as determined by appropriate
- 22 peer review; OR
- 23 (41) IS A PHYSICIAN WHO IS RESPONSIBLE FOR ESTABLISHING OR
- 24 SUPERVISING PROTOCOLS OR PROCEDURES FOR A HEALTH CARE DELIVERY SYSTEM
- 25 AND THE PROTOCOLS OR PROCEDURES FAIL TO MEET APPROPRIATE STANDARDS
- 26 FOR THE DELIVERY OF QUALITY MEDICAL CARE AS DETERMINED BY APPROPRIATE
- 27 REVIEW, EXCEPT THAT A PHYSICIAN MAY NOT BE DISCIPLINED BY THE BOARD FOR:
- 28 (I) THE INDEPENDENT JUDGMENT ERROR OF A HEALTH CARE
- 29 PROVIDER WHO IS PROVIDING DIRECT PATIENT CARE IN CONTRADICTION TO

- 32 (II) ESTABLISHING OR SUPERVISING PROTOCOLS OR PROCEDURES
