- 9 (H) FUNDS FOR THE ACADEMY SHALL BE AS PROVIDED IN THE ANNUAL 10 BUDGET OF THE DEPARTMENT.
- 11 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That:
- 12 (a) The State Department of Education shall establish a Maryland
- 13 Technology Academy Pilot Program to be in effect only during Fiscal Year 1999.
- 14 (b) The purpose of the Pilot Program is to provide intensive learning
- 15 opportunities for teachers in the State on how to use technology to significantly
- 16 impact student learning.
- 17 (c) The Department shall establish guidelines and policies to implement
- 18 the purpose of the Pilot Program, including guidelines and policies for the selection of
- 19 participants in the Pilot Program and the curriculum and format for operation of the
- 20 Pilot Program.
- 21 SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That Section 2 of this Act
- 22 shall take effect July 1, 1998.
- 23 SECTION 2. 4. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That Section 1 of this Act
- 24 shall take effect July 1, 1998 1999.
