## 1 AN ACT concerning

# 2 Maryland Stadium Authority - Termination

3	FOR the	purpose of	terminating the	Maryland Stadium	Authority and	transferring its

- 4 administrative functions, powers, and duties to the Board of Public Works on the
- 5 date the construction of a professional football stadium at Camden Yards in
- 6 Baltimore City is completed; deeming the construction of the football stadium to
- 7 be completed no later than a certain date; providing for the continuing validity
- 8 of certain transactions and certain rights, duties, and interests; providing for
- 9 the continuation of certain permits, licenses, applications, rules and regulations,
- standards, guidelines, orders, directives, forms, plans, memberships, special
- funds, appropriations, grants, contracts, property, investigations, proceedings,
- rights, duties, and responsibilities; providing for the legal effect of certain bonds,
- 13 notes, instruments, or certificates; providing for the disposition of certain funds;
- declaring certain references to the Maryland Stadium Authority to be references
- to the Board of Public Works; abolishing all positions of employment with the
- Maryland Stadium Authority; requiring a certain correction to certain
- 17 references; providing for the severability of this Act; and generally relating to
- the termination of the Maryland Stadium Authority.

#### 25 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF

- 26 MARYLAND, That on the date the construction of a professional football stadium at
- 27 Camden Yards in Baltimore City is completed Section(s) 13-701 through 13-724,
- 28 inclusive, and the subtitle "Subtitle 7. Maryland Stadium Authority" of Article -
- 29 Financial Institutions of the Annotated Code of Maryland be repealed.

### 30 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That the construction of a

31 professional football stadium at Camden Yards in Baltimore City shall be deemed to

- 1 be completed no later than the date on which the first professional football game is
- 2 played at the stadium.
- 3 SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That on and after the effective
- 4 date of this Act, the administrative functions, powers, and duties of the former
- 5 Maryland Stadium Authority under §§ 13-701 through 13-724 of the Financial
- 6 Institutions Article, as repealed by Section 1 of this Act, shall be transferred to and
- 7 performed by the Board of Public Works.
- 8 SECTION 4. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That any transaction affected
- 9 by or flowing from any statute repealed by Section 1 of this Act, which was validly
- 10 entered into before the effective date of this Act, and every right, duty, or interest
- 11 flowing from it remains valid after the effective date of this Act and may be
- 12 terminated, completed, consummated, or enforced pursuant to law.
- 13 SECTION 5. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That all permits and licenses,
- 14 applications for permits and licenses, rules and regulations, proposed rules and
- 15 regulations, standards and guidelines, orders and other directives, forms, plans,
- 16 memberships, special funds, appropriations, grants, applications for grants,
- 17 contracts, property, investigations, administrative and judicial proceedings, rights to
- 18 sue and be sued, and all other duties and responsibilities associated with those
- 19 functions of the former Maryland Stadium Authority transferred by this Act shall
- 20 continue in effect under the Board of Public Works until completed, withdrawn,
- 21 canceled, modified, or otherwise changed pursuant to law.
- 22 SECTION 6. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That all bonds, notes, bond
- 23 anticipation notes, notes in the nature of commercial paper, or other instruments,
- 24 certificates or evidence of indebtedness or obligation heretofore issued by the former
- 25 Maryland Stadium Authority are hereby declared to be valid, legal, binding and
- 26 enforceable obligations to the extent of the obligation as provided in any such bonds,
- 27 notes, instruments, certificates or evidences of indebtedness and the proceedings
- 28 relating to the issuance thereof.
- 29 SECTION 7. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That the unexpended or
- 30 unencumbered balances of any appropriation made to the former Maryland Stadium
- 31 Authority may not revert to the general fund of the State, but shall be made available
- 32 to the Board of Public Works for expenditure through an appropriation contained in a
- 33 budget bill or through an approved budget amendment.
- 34 SECTION 8. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That, in every law, executive
- 35 order, rule, regulation, policy, or document created by any official, employee, or unit of
- 36 this State or of the Maryland Stadium Authority, any reference to the former
- 37 Maryland Stadium Authority shall be deemed to be a reference to the Board of Public
- 38 Works.
- 39 SECTION 9. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That the position of Executive
- 40 Director and all other executive, professional, clerical, or other positions of
- 41 employment with the former Maryland Stadium Authority are abolished by this Act.

- 1 SECTION 10. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That, pursuant to the
- 2 transfer of authority effectuated by this Act, the publishers of the Annotated Code of
- 3 Maryland, subject to the approval of the Director of the Department of Legislative
- 4 Services, shall propose the correction of any references to the former Maryland
- 5 Stadium Authority that are rendered incorrect by this Act.
- 6 SECTION 11. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That if any provision of this
- 7 Act or the application thereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid for any
- 8 reason in a court of competent jurisdiction, the invalidity does not affect other
- 9 provisions or any other application of this Act which can be given effect without the
- 10 invalid provision or application, and for this purpose the provisions of this Act are
- 11 declared severable.
- 12 SECTION 12. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
- 13 October 1, 1998.
