- 3 FOR the purpose of establishing a Task Force to Study Unlicensed Driving; providing
- for the membership, duties, and staffing of the Task Force; requiring the Task
- Force to report to certain persons by a certain date; providing for the effective
- date of this Act; providing for the termination of this Act; and generally relating
- 7 to the Task Force to Study Unlicensed Driving.

- 13 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
- 14 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:
- 15 Article 41 Governor Executive and Administrative Departments
- 16 18-316.
- 17 (A) THERE IS A TASK FORCE TO STUDY UNLICENSED DRIVING.
- 18 (B) THE TASK FORCE CONSISTS OF THE FOLLOWING MEMBERS:
- 19 (1) THREE MEMBERS OF THE SENATE OF MARYLAND, APPOINTED BY
- 20 THE PRESIDENT OF THE SENATE;
- 21 (2) THREE MEMBERS OF THE HOUSE OF DELEGATES, APPOINTED BY
- 22 THE SPEAKER OF THE HOUSE;
- 23 (3) THE ADMINISTRATOR OF THE MOTOR VEHICLE ADMINISTRATION OR
- 24 THE ADMINISTRATOR'S DESIGNEE;
- 25 (4) THE SECRETARY OF THE DEPARTMENT OF STATE POLICE OR THE
- 26 SECRETARY'S DESIGNEE;

- 1 (5) THE MARYLAND INSURANCE ADMINISTRATION COMMISSIONER OF 2 THE MARYLAND INSURANCE ADMINISTRATION OR THE COMMISSIONER'S DESIGNEE;
- 3 (6) THE EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR OF THE MARYLAND AUTOMOBILE 4 INSURANCE FUND OR THE EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR'S DESIGNEE;
- 5 (7) A REPRESENTATIVE OF THE STATE'S ATTORNEYS' ASSOCIATION;
- 6 (8) A REPRESENTATIVE OF THE OFFICE OF THE PUBLIC DEFENDER;
- 7 (9) A REPRESENTATIVE OF THE PROPERTY AND CASUALTY INSURANCE 8 INDUSTRY; AND
- 9 (10) TWO MEMBERS APPOINTED BY THE GOVERNOR.
- 10 (C) THE GOVERNOR SHALL APPOINT THE CHAIRPERSON FROM THE MEMBERS 11 OF THE TASK FORCE.
- 12 (D) A MEMBER OF THE TASK FORCE:
- 13 (1) MAY NOT RECEIVE COMPENSATION; BUT
- 14 (2) IS ENTITLED TO REIMBURSEMENT FOR EXPENSES UNDER THE 15 STANDARD STATE TRAVEL REGULATIONS AS PROVIDED IN THE STATE BUDGET.
- 16 (E) THE TASK FORCE SHALL:
- 17 (1) EXAMINE ISSUES RELATING TO INDIVIDUALS WITHOUT VALID 18 DRIVERS' LICENSES WHO DRIVE MOTOR VEHICLES IN THE STATE; AND
- 19 (2) MAKE RECOMMENDATIONS TO THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY AND
- 20 APPROPRIATE STATE UNITS FOR STATUTORY AND ADMINISTRATIVE CHANGES TO
- 21 ADDRESS THE PROBLEMS ASSOCIATED WITH UNLICENSED DRIVING.
- 22 (F) THE DEPARTMENT OF LEGISLATIVE SERVICES, IN COOPERATION WITH
- 23 OTHER APPROPRIATE STATE UNITS, SHALL PROVIDE STAFF SUPPORT FOR THE TASK
- 24 FORCE TO THE EXTENT POSSIBLE WITHIN EXISTING BUDGET RESOURCES.
- 25 (G) ON OR BEFORE DECEMBER 1, 1998, THE TASK FORCE SHALL SUBMIT A
- 26 REPORT ON UNLICENSED DRIVING AND ITS RECOMMENDATIONS TO THE GOVERNOR
- 27 AND, SUBJECT TO § 2-1246 OF THE STATE GOVERNMENT ARTICLE, TO THE GENERAL
- 28 ASSEMBLY.
- 29 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED. That this Act shall take effect
- 30 July 1, 1998. It shall remain effective until December 1, 1998 and, at the end of
- 31 December 1, 1998, with no further action required by the General Assembly, this Act
- 32 shall be abrogated and of no further force and effect.
