15 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF16 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

17 Article 33 - Election Code 18 11-2. 19 Except as provided in paragraph [(2)(i)](2)(II) of this subsection, in (1)(g) 20 Baltimore County, members of the party central committees shall not run at large. 21 [(2) (i) Except for the Chairman, the members of the Republican 22 central committee shall be elected from the legislative districts of Baltimore County 23 as follows: 24 1. Three members shall be elected from any legislative 25 district which comprises 66% or more of its population within Baltimore County; 26 2. Two members shall be elected from any district which 27 comprises more than 33% but less than 66% of its population within Baltimore 28 County; 29 3. One member shall be elected from any legislative district 30 which comprises 33% or less of its population within Baltimore County; and 31 In any legislative district that is divided into delegate 4. 32 districts and the delegate districts are located entirely within Baltimore County: One member shall be elected from a single member 33 A. 34 delegate district; and 35 Two members shall be elected from a two member delegate B. 36 district.

The percentage of Baltimore County's population of a 5 legislative district shall be determined by the most recent United States census.] THE REPUBLICAN PARTY CENTRAL COMMITTEE SHALL CONSIST OF: 6 (2) 7 THREE MEMBERS ELECTED FROM EACH COUNTY COUNCIL (I) 8 DISTRICT IN THE COUNTY; AND 9 A CHAIRMAN ELECTED FROM THE COUNTY AT LARGE. (II)

10 SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That Section 1 of this Act shall 11 take effect June 1, 1998.

SECTION 4. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That Section 2 of this Act shalltake effect January 1, 1999.
