3 FOR the purpose of altering the minimum required local contribution to certain flood
4 management projects under the Comprehensive Flood Management Grant
5 Program; altering a certain limitation on State contributions to certain flood
6 management projects; and generally relating to the Comprehensive Flood
7 Management Grant Program.

8 BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,

13 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
14 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

15 **Article - Environment**

16 5-803.

17 (h) (6) (I) The amount of any grant made by the Department for a flood
18 control and watershed management capital project ~~INVOLVING WHICH INVOLVES~~
19 ONLY STATE AND LOCAL GOVERNMENT FUNDS AND MEETS THE CRITERIA OF THIS
20 SUBTITLE shall be matched by a minimum amount of [50%] 25% of local funds.

1 (II) ~~The Department may provide up to 50% of the nonfederal share~~
2 ~~of the funding for FOR~~ a flood control and watershed management capital project
3 WHICH INVOLVES FEDERAL FUNDING AND ~~which~~ meets the criteria of this subtitle-;

4 1. THE DEPARTMENT MAY PROVIDE UP TO 50% OF THE
5 NONFEDERAL SHARE OF THE FUNDING; AND

6 2. THE AMOUNT OF ANY GRANT MADE BY THE DEPARTMENT
7 SHALL BE MATCHED BY A MINIMUM AMOUNT OF 50% OF LOCAL FUNDS.

8 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
9 July 1, 1998.
