1 AN ACT concerning

2 Vehicle Laws - Driver's License Revocation - Request for Hearing

- 3 FOR the purpose of requiring the Motor Vehicle Administration, in the case of a
- driver's license revocation, to hold a hearing for a certain purpose if a request for
- 5 a hearing is made by the licensee within a certain period after the deadline for
- 6 requesting a hearing has passed; requiring a hearing under this Act to be held
- 7 within a certain time period; and generally relating to hearings on the
- 8 revocation of drivers' licenses.

14 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF

15 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

16 Article - Transportation

- 17 12-203.
- 18 (a) If the Maryland Vehicle Law or a rule or regulation of the Administration
- 19 provides that an applicant or licensee may request a hearing on refusal, suspension,
- 20 or revocation of a license or privilege, the Administration shall give the applicant or
- 21 licensee written notice under § 12-114 of this title of:
- 22 (1) The refusal, suspension, or revocation; and
- 23 (2) The right of the applicant or licensee to request a hearing.
- 24 (b) (1) Except as otherwise provided in the Maryland Vehicle Law, the
- 25 applicant or licensee may request a hearing within 15 days from the date that the
- 26 notice required by this section is mailed.

- 1 (2) The hearing shall be held within 30 days of the date of the request.
- 2 (3) IF A REQUEST FOR A HEARING ON THE REVOCATION OF A LICENSE IS
- 3 NOT MADE WITHIN 15 DAYS FROM THE DATE THAT THE NOTICE REQUIRED BY THIS
- 4 SECTION IS MAILED, BUT THE LICENSEE REQUESTS A HEARING WITHIN 180 DAYS
- 5 FROM THE DATE THAT THE NOTICE WAS MAILED, WITHIN 30 DAYS OF THE DATE OF
- 6 THE REQUEST, THE ADMINISTRATION SHALL HOLD A HEARING AT WHICH THE
- 7 LICENSEE SHALL SHOW CAUSE WHY THE DRIVER'S LICENSE SHOULD NOT BE
- 8 REVOKED.
- 9 [(3)] (4) The Administration shall render a decision within 30 days of a 10 hearing conducted under Title 16, Subtitles 1 through 4 of this article.
- 11 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
- 12 October 1, 1998.
