- 15 (c) (1) Except on interstate highways, a vehicle carrying agricultural
- 16 products as defined under § 10-601 of the Agriculture Article or forest products that
- 17 have been loaded in fields or other off-highway locations is permitted an axle load
- 18 limit tolerance of 10 percent.
- 19 Except on interstate highways, a single unit vehicle with 3 axles, or a
- 20 combination of vehicles with a trailer less than 32 feet long, either registered as a
- 21 farm vehicle or carrying agricultural products as defined under § 10-601 of the
- 22 Agriculture Article that were loaded in fields or other off-highway locations, is
- 23 permitted an axle load limit tolerance of 5 percent from § 24-109(b) and (c) of this
- 24 subtitle, except during harvest time when a tolerance of 15 percent from § 24-109(b)
- 25 and (c) of this subtitle is permitted for a vehicle carrying the following agricultural

- 27 (i) Wheat, for the period from June 1 to August 15;
