11 12	SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

17	5 (c) (1) Except on interstate highways, a vehicle carrying agricultural 5 products as defined under § 10-601 of the Agriculture Article or forest products that 7 have been loaded in fields or other off-highway locations is permitted an axle load 8 limit tolerance of 10 percent.

19 (2) Except on interstate highways, a single unit vehicle with 3 axles, or a 20 combination of vehicles with a trailer less than 32 feet long, either registered as a

- 1 farm vehicle or carrying agricultural products as defined under § 10-601 of the
- 2 Agriculture Article that were loaded in fields or other off-highway locations, is
- 3 permitted an axle load limit tolerance of 5 percent from § 24-109(b) and (c) of this
- 4 subtitle, except during harvest time when a tolerance of 15 percent from § 24-109(b)
- 5 and (c) of this subtitle is permitted for a vehicle carrying the following agricultural

- 7 (i) Wheat, for the period from June 1 to August 15;
