A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 Creation of a State Debt - Prince George's County - Kettering

- 3 FOR the purpose of authorizing the creation of a State Debt in the amount of
- 4 \$266,000, the proceeds to be used as a grant to the Kettering Community
- 5 Homeowners Association for certain acquisition, development, or improvement
- 6 purposes; providing for disbursement of the loan proceeds; and providing
- 7 generally for the issuance and sale of bonds evidencing the loan.

8 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF

- 9 MARYLAND, That:
- 10 (1) The Board of Public Works may borrow money and incur indebtedness on
- 11 behalf of the State of Maryland through a State loan to be known as the Prince
- 12 George's County Kettering Loan of 1998 in the total principal amount of \$266,000.
- 13 This loan shall be evidenced by the issuance, sale, and delivery of State general
- 14 obligation bonds authorized by a resolution of the Board of Public Works and issued,
- 15 sold, and delivered in accordance with §§ 8-117 through 8-124 of the State Finance
- 16 and Procurement Article and Article 31, § 22 of the Code.
- 17 (2) The bonds to evidence this loan or installments of this loan may be sold as
- 18 a single issue or may be consolidated and sold as part of a single issue of bonds under
- 19 § 8-122 of the State Finance and Procurement Article.
- 20 (3) The cash proceeds of the sale of the bonds shall be paid to the Treasurer
- 21 and first shall be applied to the payment of the expenses of issuing, selling, and
- 22 delivering the bonds, unless funds for this purpose are otherwise provided, and then
- 23 shall be credited on the books of the Comptroller and expended, on approval by the
- 24 Board of Public Works, for the following public purposes, including any applicable
- 25 architects' and engineers' fees: as a grant to Kettering Community Homeowners
- 26 Association for the planning, design, repair, rehabilitation, reconstruction,
- 27 construction, and capital equipping and furnishing of the community center in
- 28 Kettering, a facility that is used by the residents of Kettering for children's activities,
- 29 as well as adult meetings and other functions of the community.

- 1 (4) An annual State tax is imposed on all assessable property in the State in 2 rate and amount sufficient to pay the principal of and interest on the bonds, as and 3 when due and until paid in full. The principal shall be discharged within 15 years

- 4 after the date of issuance of the bonds.
- 5 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
- 6 June 1, 1998.
