## HOUSE JOINT RESOLUTION

1 A House Joint Resolution concerning

## 2 Cloning of Humans

- 3 FOR the purpose of expressing the intent of the General Assembly of Maryland to ban
- 4 State funding of cloning and cloning research that would replicate a human
- 5 being.
- 6 WHEREAS, Scottish scientist Ian Wilmut has generated both awe and angst
- 7 with his successful cloning of a mammal; and
- 8 WHEREAS, The principles of industrial production and design, such as quality
- 9 control, predictability, profitability, and efficiency, should never be allowed to apply to
- 10 the production of humans; and
- WHEREAS, Social, ethical, and moral values should not be sacrificed in favor of
- 12 the dubious potential benefits of scientific experimentation in human cloning; and
- 13 WHEREAS, Cloning would tend to devalue human life or dehumanize mankind;
- 14 and
- WHEREAS, In a recent poll, 90% of respondents favored prohibiting cloning by
- 16 law; now, therefore, be it
- 17 RESOLVED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That it is the
- 18 intent of the General Assembly of Maryland to ban State funding of cloning and
- 19 cloning research that would replicate a human being; and be it further
- 20 RESOLVED, That a copy of this Resolution be forwarded by the Department of
- 21 Legislative Services to the Honorable Parris N. Glendening, Governor of Maryland;
- 22 the Honorable Thomas V. Mike Miller, Jr., President of the Senate of Maryland; and
- 23 the Honorable Casper R. Taylor, Jr., Speaker of the House of Delegates.
