HOUSE JOINT RESOLUTION

1 A House Joint Resolution concerning

2 **General Assembly Compensation - Rejection of Increases**

3 FOR the purpose of rejecting, in its entirety, the Resolution of the General Assembly  
4 Compensation Commission dated January 7, 1998; and providing that the levels  
5 of compensation, allowances, pensions, and other benefits for members of the  
6 General Assembly shall remain at the levels set by the Resolution of the General  
7 Assembly Compensation Commission dated January 20, 1994.

8 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That:

9 (a) In accordance with the authority granted under Article III, § 15 of the  
10 Maryland Constitution, the General Assembly rejects the recommendations for  
11 changes in compensation, allowances, and other benefits submitted in the Resolution  
12 of the General Assembly Compensation Commission dated January 7, 1998;

13 (b) The Resolution of the General Assembly Compensation Commission dated  
14 January 7, 1998 shall be void; and

15 (c) The compensation, allowances, pensions, and other benefits to members of  
16 the General Assembly shall be as provided in the Resolution of the General Assembly  
17 Salary Commission dated January, 20, 1994.
