- 10 Maryland Constitution, the General Assembly rejects the recommendations for
- 11 changes in compensation, allowances, and other benefits submitted in the Resolution
- 12 of the General Assembly Compensation Commission dated January 7, 1998;
- 13 (b) The Resolution of the General Assembly Compensation Commission dated
- 14 January 7, 1998 shall be void; and
- 15 (c) The compensation, allowances, pensions, and other benefits to members of
- 16 the General Assembly shall be as provided in the Resolution of the General Assembly
