2 Prospective Jurors - Motor Vehicle Administration Lists

- 3 FOR the purpose of expanding the sources from which prospective jurors shall be
- 4 selected by the jury commissioner or clerk of the court to include lists of certain
- 5 individuals who have been issued a driver's license or an identification card by
- 6 the Motor Vehicle Administration; requiring the Administration to make
- 7 available to the jury commissioners or clerks certain lists without cost; making
- 8 stylistic changes; providing for a delayed effective date; and generally relating to
- 9 the selection of prospective jurors.

- 15 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
- 16 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

17 Article - Courts and Judicial Proceedings

- 19 (A) The jury commissioner or the clerk of the court shall select the names of
- 20 prospective jurors from among:
- 21 (1) [those] THOSE persons AT LEAST 18 years old [or older] whose
- 22 names appear on the voter registration lists[,];
- 23 (2) THE LIST OF INDIVIDUALS AT LEAST 18 YEARS OLD WHO HAVE BEEN
- 24 ISSUED A DRIVER'S LICENSE BY THE MOTOR VEHICLE ADMINISTRATION;
- 25 (3) THE LIST OF INDIVIDUALS AT LEAST 18 YEARS OLD WHO HAVE BEEN
- 26 ISSUED AN IDENTIFICATION CARD BY THE MOTOR VEHICLE ADMINISTRATION; and

- 1 (4) [from such additional] ADDITIONAL sources permitted by a plan 2 adopted under § 8-201 OF THIS TITLE.
- 3 (B) Volunteers for jury service shall be refused, and recommendations, if made, 4 may not be accepted.
- 5 8-204.
- 6 (A) Any State or local official who has custody, possession, or control of voter
- 7 registration lists shall make the lists and records available to the jury commissioner
- 8 or clerks for inspection and copying at any reasonable time.
- 9 (B) (1) THE MOTOR VEHICLE ADMINISTRATION SHALL MAKE AVAILABLE TO
- 10 THE JURY COMMISSIONER OR CLERKS FOR INSPECTION AND COPYING AT ANY
- 11 REASONABLE TIME:
- 12 (I) THE LIST OF INDIVIDUALS WHO ARE AT LEAST 18 YEARS OLD
- 13 AND HAVE BEEN ISSUED A DRIVER'S LICENSE BY THE MOTOR VEHICLE
- 14 ADMINISTRATION: AND
- 15 (II) THE LIST OF INDIVIDUALS WHO ARE AT LEAST 18 YEARS OLD
- 16 AND HAVE BEEN ISSUED AN IDENTIFICATION CARD BY THE MOTOR VEHICLE
- 17 ADMINISTRATION.
- 18 (2) THE LISTS DESCRIBED IN THIS SUBSECTION SHALL BE PROVIDED BY
- 19 THE MOTOR VEHICLE ADMINISTRATION TO THE JURY COMMISSIONER OR CLERKS
- 20 WITHOUT COST.
- 21 (C) The circuit court of a county upon application by the Attorney General,
- 22 may compel compliance with this section.
- 23 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
- 24 January 1, 1999.
