- 13 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
- 14 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

15 Article - Insurance

- 17 (e) An insurer may not refuse to underwrite a private passenger motor vehicle
- 18 insurance risk solely:
- 19 (1) because the applicant or named insured previously obtained
- 20 insurance coverage from any authorized insurer or the Maryland Automobile
- 21 Insurance Fund; OR
- 22 (2) BECAUSE OF THE CREDIT HISTORY OF THE APPLICANT OR NAMED
- 23 INSURED.
- 24 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take
- 25 effect October 1, 1998.
