2 Vehicle Laws - Changing Lanes - Lane Must Be Clear

- 3 FOR the purpose of altering a certain provision in order to prohibit the driver of a
- 4 vehicle from changing lanes or moving from a shoulder or bikeway into a lane
- 5 until the lane is clear so that the vehicle may enter and occupy the lane without
- 6 danger to any other vehicle.
- 7 BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,

- 10 Annotated Code of Maryland
- 11 (1992 Replacement Volume and 1997 Supplement)
- 12 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
- 13 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

14 Article - Transportation

15 21-309.

- 16 (b) A vehicle shall be driven as nearly as practicable entirely within a single
- 17 lane and may not be moved from that lane or moved from a shoulder or bikeway into
- 18 a lane until the [driver has determined that it is safe to do so] LANE IS CLEAR SO
- 19 THAT THE VEHICLE CHANGING LANES MAY ENTER AND OCCUPY THE LANE WITHOUT
- 20 DANGER TO ANY OTHER VEHICLE.
- 21 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
- 22 October 1, 1998.
