2 Education - Public Schools - Required Curriculum

- 3 FOR the purpose of requiring certain public schools in the State to include certain
- 4 lessons in the curriculum of students; requiring the State Board of Education to
- 5 adopt regulations to implement the provisions of this Act; and generally relating
- 6 to the curriculum required in public schools in the State.
- 7 BY adding to

- Preamble 12
- WHEREAS, This year marks the 151st anniversary of the worst year of the
- 14 mass starvation that occurred in Ireland between 1845 and 1850; and
- WHEREAS, By 1845, the people of Ireland depended on the potato as the main
- 16 ingredient of their diet and their economy, and by 1847, 90 percent of the potato crop
- 17 in Ireland was diseased by the fungus, Phytophthora infestans; and
- WHEREAS, Between 1845 and 1847, over one million pounds sterling worth of
- 19 food was exported out of Ireland under the supervision of the British government; and
- WHEREAS, Between 1845 and 1850, over one million people of Ireland died and
- 21 over one million people emigrated from Ireland to the United States, Canada,
- 22 Australia, and Britain; and
- WHEREAS, The curriculum taught in the public schools of this State should
- 24 instruct the youth of this State about this devastating tragedy of humankind that
- 25 created the first boat people of modern Europe; and
- 26 WHEREAS, The history books that have been used to educate the students in
- 27 the public schools of this State have largely neglected the suffering of the Irish people

- 1 that transpired under the insensitive and systematically oppressive policies of the
- 2 British government; now, therefore,
- 3 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
- 4 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:
- 5 Article Education
- 6 7-113.
- 7 (A) THE STATE BOARD SHALL REQUIRE EACH PUBLIC ELEMENTARY SCHOOL
- 8 AND EACH PUBLIC SECONDARY SCHOOL IN THE STATE TO INSTRUCT ITS STUDENTS
- 9 IN THE HISTORICAL CAUSES, EFFECTS, AND LESSONS OF THE MASS STARVATION
- 10 THAT OCCURRED IN IRELAND BETWEEN 1845 AND 1850.
- 11 (B) THE STATE BOARD SHALL ADOPT REGULATIONS TO IMPLEMENT THE
- 12 PROVISIONS OF THIS SECTION.
- 13 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
- 14 July 1, 1998.
