Education - Public Schools School Systems - Required Curriculum

3 FOR the purpose of requiring eertain public schools school systems in the State to

4 include certain lessons in the curriculum of students; requiring the State Board

5 of Education to adopt regulations to implement the provisions of this Act; and

6 generally relating to the curriculum required in public schools school systems in

7 the State.

Preamble

14 WHEREAS, This year marks the 151st anniversary of the worst year of the

15 mass starvation that occurred in Ireland between 1845 and 1850; and

16 WHEREAS, By 1845, the people of Ireland depended on the potato as the main

17 ingredient of their diet and their economy, and by 1847, 90 percent of the potato crop 18 in Ireland was diseased by the fungus, Phytophthora infestans; and

19 WHEREAS, Between 1845 and 1847, over one million pounds sterling worth of 20 food was exported out of Ireland under the supervision of the British government; and

1 WHEREAS, Between 1845 and 1850, over one million people of Ireland died and 2 over one million people emigrated from Ireland to the United States, Canada, 3 Australia, and Britain; and

4 WHEREAS, The curriculum taught in the public schools of this State should 5 instruct the youth of this State about this devastating tragedy of humankind that 6 created the first boat people of modern Europe; and

7 WHEREAS, The history books that have been used to educate the students in 8 the public schools of this State have largely neglected the suffering of the Irish people 9 that transpired under the insensitive and systematically oppressive policies of the 10 British government; now, therefore,

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

13 Article - Education

14 7-113.

(A) THE STATE BOARD SHALL REQUIRE EACH PUBLIC ELEMENTARY SCHOOL
AND EACH PUBLIC SECONDARY SCHOOL SCHOOL SYSTEM IN THE STATE TO
INSTRUCT ITS STUDENTS IN THE HISTORICAL CAUSES, EFFECTS, AND LESSONS OF
THE MASS STARVATION THAT OCCURRED IN IRELAND BETWEEN 1845 AND 1850.

19 (B) THE STATE BOARD SHALL ADOPT REGULATIONS TO IMPLEMENT THE 20 PROVISIONS OF THIS SECTION.

21 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 22 July 1, 1998.
