- at retail, offered for sale, or dispensed through a window or door to a purchaser
- 6 in or on a motor vehicle for off-premises consumption; repealing a duplicative
- 7 local provision; and generally relating to the operation of drive-through
- 8 facilities for the sale of alcoholic beverages.

19 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF

20 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

21 Article 2B - Alcoholic Beverages

- 23 AN ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES LICENSEE MAY NOT SELL, OFFER TO SELL, OR
- 24 DISPENSE ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES FOR OFF-PREMISES CONSUMPTION THROUGH A
- 25 FACILITY COMMONLY KNOWN AS A WALK-UP OR DRIVE-THROUGH WINDOW.

- This section applies only in Carroll County. 2 (a)
- 3 (b) A licensee may not sell, offer to sell, or dispense any alcoholic beverages 4 from what is commonly termed a walk-up or drive-through window.]

- 6 October 1, 1998.
