A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Alcoholic Beverages - Walk-Up or Drive-Through Facilities - Prohibition**

3 FOR the purpose of prohibiting an alcoholic beverages licensee from operating a  
4 walk-up or drive-through purchase facility where alcoholic beverages are sold  
5 at retail, offered for sale, or dispensed through a window or door to a purchaser  
6 in or on a motor vehicle for off-premises consumption; repealing a duplicative  
7 local provision; and generally relating to the operation of drive-through  
8 facilities for the sale of alcoholic beverages.

19 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF  
20 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

21 **Article 2B - Alcoholic Beverages**

22 12-114.

23 AN ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES LICENSEE MAY NOT SELL, OFFER TO SELL, OR  
24 DISPENSE ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES FOR OFF-PREMISES CONSUMPTION THROUGH A  
25 FACILITY COMMONLY KNOWN AS A WALK-UP OR DRIVE-THROUGH WINDOW.

2 (a) This section applies only in Carroll County.

3 (b) A licensee may not sell, offer to sell, or dispense any alcoholic beverages  
4 from what is commonly termed a walk-up or drive-through window.]

5 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect  
6 October 1, 1998.
