## 2 Inmates - Diminution Credits - Revocation

- 3 FOR the purpose of authorizing the Division of Correction under certain
- 4 circumstances to revoke from an inmate, who has been transferred to the
- 5 custody of the Division, diminution credits that the inmate was allowed while in
- a local detention center; defining a certain term; and generally relating to
- diminution credits allowed for inmates in the custody of the Division of
- 8 Correction.

- 14 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
- 15 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

## 16 Article 27 - Crimes and Punishments

- 18 (g) (1) IN THIS SUBSECTION, "LOCAL DETENTION CENTER" MEANS A
- 19 COUNTY OR TOWN JAIL, WORK RELEASE OR PRERELEASE CENTER, THE BALTIMORE
- 20 CITY DETENTION CENTER, OR ANY CORRECTIONAL FACILITY OPERATED BY ONE OR
- 21 MORE COUNTIES FOR THE PURPOSE OF ADULT DETENTION AND CONFINEMENT.
- 22 (2) For a violation of the applicable rules of discipline, the Division OF
- 23 CORRECTION may revoke a portion or all of the deductions:
- 24 (I) [allowed] ALLOWED under subsections (d) and (h) of this
- 25 section according to the nature and frequency of the violation; OR
- 26 (II) ALLOWED BY A LOCAL DETENTION CENTER TO AN INMATE
- 27 WHO HAS BEEN TRANSFERRED TO THE CUSTODY OF THE DIVISION OF CORRECTION.

- 1 (3) The deductions allowed and earned under subsections (e) and (f) of
- 2 this section shall not be affected by the provisions of this subsection. Any credits
- 3 forfeited pursuant to this subsection may be restored. The Commissioner shall
- 4 promulgate rules and regulations governing the restoration of forfeited credits.
- 5 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
- 6 October 1, 1998.
