5	The Department shall at least monthly publish statistics concerning the occurrence and cause of all motor vehicle accidents within the State. The Department shall also publish periodic statistics of the incidence of crime within the State. No such statistical report shall name or otherwise identify a particular known or

7 suspected offender. Reports required by this section shall be distributed to all

8 agencies which contributed information contained in such reports, to the press, and to

9 all other interested persons. In addition, the Secretary may prescribe by rule the

10 conditions under which reports of specific motor vehicle accidents may be made

11 available upon request to the public; and the fee for conducting a document search is

12 [\$2] \$5 \$4 and the moneys received therefrom shall be used by the Department to be

13 applied to the cost of providing this service.

14 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take 15 effect July 1, 1998.
