- 11 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
- 12 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

- 15 The Department shall at least monthly publish statistics concerning the
- 16 occurrence and cause of all motor vehicle accidents within the State. The Department
- 17 shall also publish periodic statistics of the incidence of crime within the State. No
- 18 such statistical report shall name or otherwise identify a particular known or
- 19 suspected offender. Reports required by this section shall be distributed to all
- 20 agencies which contributed information contained in such reports, to the press, and to
- 21 all other interested persons. In addition, the Secretary may prescribe by rule the

- 1 conditions under which reports of specific motor vehicle accidents may be made
 2 available upon request to the public; and the fee for conducting a document search is
- 3 [\$2] \$5 and the moneys received therefrom shall be used by the Department to be
- 4 applied to the cost of providing this service.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take 5
- 6 effect July 1, 1998.
