10 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF

11 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

12 **Article - Business Occupations and Professions** 13 14-202. The Board consists of [6] SEVEN members. 14 (a) (1) 15 (2) Of the [6] SEVEN members of the Board: [4] FIVE shall be engineers; and 16 (i) [2] TWO shall be consumer members. 17 (ii)
