1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Security System Technicians - Security System - Definition**

3 FOR the purpose of defining "security system" in a provision of law relating to the
4 licensure of security system technicians; and generally relating to security
5 system technicians.

11 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
12 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

13 **Article - Business Occupations and Professions**

14 18-101.

15 (K) "SECURITY SYSTEM" MEANS:

16 (1) A LOCK, DEAD BOLT, OR OTHER MECHANICAL,
17 ELECTROMECHANICAL, OR ELECTRONIC DEVICE OR SYSTEM OPERATED BY A KEY,
18 COMBINATION, KEYCARD, OR PASS CODE USED FOR SECURING A DOOR OR WINDOW;

19 (2) AN ELECTRONIC SYSTEM INTENDED TO PROVIDE A DISTRESS CALL
20 OR ALARM IN THE EVENT OF FIRE OR UNLAWFUL ENTRY, OTHER THAN:

21 (I) A DEVICE OR SYSTEM INSTALLED IN A VEHICLE; OR

22 (II) A SMOKE DETECTOR THAT PROVIDES ONLY AN AUDIBLE
23 ALARM; OR

24 (3) A CLOSED CIRCUIT TELEVISION SURVEILLANCE SYSTEM.

1 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take
2 effect October 1, 1998.
