- 18 COMBINATION, KEYCARD, OR PASS CODE USED FOR SECURING A DOOR OR WINDOW;
- 19 (2) AN ELECTRONIC SYSTEM INTENDED TO PROVIDE A DISTRESS CALL
- 20 OR ALARM IN THE EVENT OF FIRE OR UNLAWFUL ENTRY, OTHER THAN:
- 21 (I) A DEVICE OR SYSTEM INSTALLED IN A VEHICLE; OR
- 22 (II) A SMOKE DETECTOR THAT PROVIDES ONLY AN AUDIBLE
- 23 ALARM; OR
- 24 (3) A CLOSED CIRCUIT TELEVISION SURVEILLANCE SYSTEM.
