A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Explosives - Forfeiture of Vehicle, Vessel, or Aircraft**

3 FOR the purpose of adding the State as a governmental body eligible to receive
4 certain forfeited property; and generally relating to the forfeiture of vehicles,
5 vessels, or aircraft.

6 BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,
7 Article 38A - Fires and Investigations

9 Annotated Code of Maryland

11 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
12 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

13 **Article 38A - Fires and Investigations**

14 34F.

15 In addition to any other fines or penalties provided for a violation of the
16 provisions of this subtitle, any motor vehicle or other vehicle, vessel or aircraft used
17 or employed in the concealment, conveying or transporting of any explosives during
18 the course of any violation of this subtitle by any person or persons on whom a penalty
19 and/or fine is imposed under the provisions of § 34A or § 34B, shall upon the
20 conviction or convictions be declared by the court to be forfeited to the [county or to
21 Baltimore City,] STATE, TO THE COUNTY, OR TO BALTIMORE CITY as the case may be;
22 provided that no vehicle shall be forfeited hereunder unless the owner thereof
23 authorized or permitted such use or employment, and provided further that the
24 interest thereby transferred to the [county or Baltimore City] STATE, COUNTY, OR
25 BALTIMORE CITY shall be subordinate to the interest of the holder of any perfected
26 security interest in such vehicle, vessel, or aircraft. The SECRETARY OF THE
27 DEPARTMENT OF STATE POLICE, county commissioners or the Mayor and City
28 Council of Baltimore City at their discretion, and after discharging any perfected

1 security interest in such vehicle, vessel or aircraft, may use the same for public
2 purposes or may exchange, sell or convey it to another person or persons; and any
3 cash or moneys received therefor shall be added to the general funds of the [county or
4 Baltimore City] STATE, COUNTY, OR BALTIMORE CITY.

5 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take
6 effect October 1, 1998.
