- 12 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
- 13 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

- 16 (b) An Assistant Adjutant General for Army shall:
- 17 (1) [be] BE appointed by the Governor and [his term of office shall be] 18 SERVE at the pleasure of the Governor[.];
- 19 (2) [He shall have] HAVE a commissioned grade not above that of
- 20 brigadier general, UNLESS SELECTED AS COMMANDER OF THE 29TH INFANTRY
- 21 DIVISION (LIGHT) AND FEDERALLY RECOGNIZED AS A MAJOR GENERAL;
- 22 (3) [and his salary shall be] HAVE A SALARY as stated in the annual
- 23 budget[.]; AND
- 24 (4) [He will perform] PERFORM such military duties as may be assigned
- 25 [to him] by the Governor or by the Adjutant General.

1 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take 2 effect October 1, 1998.
