A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Military Department - Assistant Adjutant General for Army**

3 FOR the purpose of allowing the Assistant Adjutant General for Army to have a
4 commissioned grade above that of Brigadier General under certain
5 circumstances; making technical changes; and generally relating to the State
6 Military Department.

7 BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,
8 Article 65 - Militia
9 Section 9(b)
10 Annotated Code of Maryland
11 (1995 Replacement Volume and 1997 Supplement)

12 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
13 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

14 **Article 65 - Militia**

15 9.

16 (b) An Assistant Adjutant General for Army shall:

17 (1) [be] BE appointed by the Governor and [his term of office shall be]
18 SERVE at the pleasure of the Governor[.];

19 (2) [He shall have] HAVE a commissioned grade not above that of
20 brigadier general, UNLESS SELECTED AS COMMANDER OF THE 29TH INFANTRY
21 DIVISION (LIGHT) AND FEDERALLY RECOGNIZED AS A MAJOR GENERAL;

22 (3) [and his salary shall be] HAVE A SALARY as stated in the annual
23 budget[.]; AND

24 (4) [He will perform] PERFORM such military duties as may be assigned
25 [to him] by the Governor or by the Adjutant General.

1 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take
2 effect October 1, 1998.
