	of the Motor Vehicle Administration for an organizational license plate, using the							
	emblem or logo adopted under Section 1 of this Act in combination with the name of							
	the organization or an appropriate slogan approved by the Administration that relates							
	to the issue of dog and cat population management. An animal humane society or							
	similar organization that obtains an organizational license plate using the emblem or							
	logo adopted under Section 1 of this Act may collect a fee set by the organization from							
	any person seeking an organizational registration plate through the organization. The							
	fee is intended to be for the purpose of humanely sterilizing dogs and cats and is in							
	3 <u>addition to any fee collected by the Motor Vehicle Administration under § 13-619 of the</u> 3 Transportation Article. The fee is to be collected directly by the organization and not
