A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Election Law - County of Residence - Repeal**

3 FOR the purpose of repealing a provision in the Election Code that requires a
4 candidate's county of residence to appear on the ballot if the contest is for an
5 office that represents more than one county; and providing for a delayed
6 effective date.

14 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
15 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

16 **Article 33 - Election Code**

17 9-210.

18 (h) [(1) In an election for an office that represents more than one county, in
19 whole or in part, the name of a candidate shall be identified by the county in which
20 the candidate resides.

21 (2)] A candidate for President of the United States or Vice President of
22 the United States shall be identified by the state in which the candidate resides.

23 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take
24 effect January 1, 1999.
