15 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF 16 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

19 (a) (1) Registration is closed between 9 p.m. on the 5th Monday preceding 20 any primary election, special primary election, general election, or special election 21 and the 11th day after that election.

- 2 SUBSEQUENT ELECTION PRIOR TO THE PRIMARY ELECTION IN 2002, REGISTRATION

- 4 THE 11TH DAY AFTER THAT ELECTION.
- 5 (3) BEGINNING WITH THE PRIMARY ELECTION IN 2002, AND FOR ANY
- 6 SUBSEQUENT ELECTION, REGISTRATION IS CLOSED BEGINNING AT 9 P.M. ON THE
- 7 21ST DAY PRECEDING AN ELECTION UNTIL THE 11TH DAY AFTER THAT ELECTION.
- 8 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
