The petitioner is not liable for the costs of the recount if: 21 (2) 22 (i) The outcome of the election is changed; [or] 23 The petitioner has gained a number of votes, for the petitioner's (ii) 24 candidacy or for or against the question that is the subject of the petition, equal to 2% 25 or more of the total votes cast for the office or on the question, in all precincts being
