A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Circuit Court Clerks - Salary**

3 FOR the purpose of altering the maximum salary that the Board of Public Works may
4 set for a clerk of the circuit court of a county; and providing that this Act does
5 not apply to the salary or compensation of an incumbent clerk.

11 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
12 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

13 **Article - Courts and Judicial Proceedings**

14 2-504.

15 (a) The clerk of each circuit court shall receive an annual salary of not less
16 than \$10,000 or more than [~~\$64,000~~] \$75,000 as set by the Board of Public Works on
17 the basis of the relative volume of business and receipts in his office. In Baltimore
18 City, the clerk's salary may not be less than \$12,000.

19 (b) A clerk shall devote his full working time to the duties of his office and is
20 entitled to the salary prescribed in subsection (a).

21 (c) The salary of a clerk is payable biweekly.

22 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That, pursuant to Article III,
23 Section 35 of the Constitution of Maryland, this Act may not be construed to extend or
24 apply to the salary or compensation of the clerk of each circuit court in office on the
25 effective date of this Act, but the provisions of this Act concerning the salary or
26 compensation of the clerk of each circuit court shall take effect at the beginning of the
27 next following term of office.

1 SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
2 October 1, 1998.
