1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Office of Cemetery Oversight - Religious, Nonprofit Cemeteries**

3 FOR the purpose of repealing a certain provision that applies to a person that owns
4 and operates a bona fide religious, nonprofit cemetery and sells preneed goods;
5 expanding the scope of a certain exemption; and generally relating to
6 cemeteries.

20 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
21 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

2 [SECTION 9. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That the provisions of this
3 Act relating to the registration or permitting of a person that owns and operates a
4 bona fide religious, nonprofit cemetery and sells preneed goods shall take effect on
5 October 1, 1999.]

Article - Business Regulation

7 5-102.

8 (a) The registration and permitting provisions of this title do not apply to a
9 person that owns and operates a bona fide religious, nonprofit cemetery in this State
10 [and does not sell preneed goods].

11 5-405.

12 Except for a cemetery in which no burials have taken place within the previous
13 5 years, a bona fide religious, nonprofit cemetery that is exempt under § 5-102 of this
14 title from the registration and permitting requirements of this title shall file with the
15 Office, once every 2 years, a statement that includes:

16 (1) the name and address of the cemetery;

17 (2) the name and address of the religious organization that owns and
18 operates the cemetery; and

19 (3) the name and address of the individual who is responsible for the
20 oversight of the cemetery.

21 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
22 October 1, 1998.
