- 20 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
- 21 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

- 2 [SECTION 9. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That the provisions of this
- 3 Act relating to the registration or permitting of a person that owns and operates a
- 4 bona fide religious, nonprofit cemetery and sells preneed goods shall take effect on
- 5 October 1, 1999.]

- 8 (a) The registration and permitting provisions of this title do not apply to a 9 person that owns and operates a bona fide religious, nonprofit cemetery in this State
- 10 [and does not sell preneed goods].
- 11 5-405.
- Except for a cemetery in which no burials have taken place within the previous
- 13 5 years, a bona fide religious, nonprofit cemetery that is exempt under § 5-102 of this
- 14 title from the registration and permitting requirements of this title shall file with the
- 15 Office, once every 2 years, a statement that includes:
- 16 (1) the name and address of the cemetery;
- 17 (2) the name and address of the religious organization that owns and
- 18 operates the cemetery; and
- 19 (3) the name and address of the individual who is responsible for the
- 20 oversight of the cemetery.
- 21 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
- 22 October 1, 1998.
