CHAPTER _____

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Fire Marshal - Deceased Member - Issuance of Flag**

3 FOR the purpose of providing that a Maryland State flag shall be issued to the family
4 of any sworn member of the State Fire Marshal's Office who was killed in the
5 line of duty; providing that the flag shall be presented by the State Senator of
6 the legislative district in which the deceased resided or served; altering a similar
7 provision relating to deceased firefighters to provide for presentation by the
8 State Senator of the legislative district in which the firefighter resided or
9 served; and generally relating to the State Fire Marshal's Office.

1 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
2 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

3 **Article 38A - Fires and Investigations**

4 44.

5 The Secretary of State of Maryland shall issue a Maryland State flag to the
6 family of any firefighter OR SWORN MEMBER OF THE STATE FIRE MARSHAL'S OFFICE
7 killed in the line of duty. The flag shall be presented to the family of the deceased
8 firefighter or policeman, OR SWORN MEMBER by the State Senator of the legislative
9 district in Maryland in which the deceased ~~resided~~ OR SERVED.

10 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
11 October 1, 1998.
