CHAPTER _____

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **State Lottery Commission - Compensation and Reimbursement**

3 FOR the purpose of allowing the members of the State Lottery Commission to receive
4 compensation and reimbursement for reasonable expenses incurred in the
5 performance of the duties as a member, as provided in the State budget; setting
6 the amount of compensation a member may receive for each meeting attended;
7 setting a limit on the amount a member may receive each year; and generally
8 relating to compensation and reimbursement for members of the State Lottery
9 Commission.

5 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
 6 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

7 **Article - State Government**

8 9-101.

9 (a) In this subtitle the following words have the meanings indicated.

10 (c) "Commission" means the State Lottery Commission.

11 9-108.

12 (d) ~~A~~ AS PROVIDED IN THE STATE BUDGET, A member of the Commission:

13 (1) may [not] receive compensation AS PAYMENT FOR ATTENDANCE AT
 14 COMMISSION MEETINGS OR OTHER LOTTERY FUNCTIONS IN AN ~~THE~~ AMOUNT OF:

15 (I) ~~UP TO \$3,000~~ \$125 PER MEETING ATTENDED, NOT TO EXCEED
 16 \$1,500 ANNUALLY FOR A COMMISSION MEMBER WHO IS NOT THE CHAIRMAN; AND

17 (II) ~~UP TO \$4,000~~ \$165 PER MEETING ATTENDED, NOT TO EXCEED
 18 \$2,000 ANNUALLY FOR THE COMMISSION CHAIRMAN; [but] AND

19 (2) is entitled to reimbursement for reasonable expenses incurred in the
 20 performance of the duties as a member, ~~as provided in the State budget.~~

21 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take
 22 effect October 1, 1998.
