3 FOR the purpose of allowing the members of the State Lottery Commission to receive

4 compensation and reimbursement for reasonable expenses incurred in the

5 performance of the duties as a member, as provided in the State budget; *setting*

6 *the amount of compensation a member may receive for each meeting attended;*

7 setting a limit on the amount a member may receive each year; and generally

8 relating to compensation and reimbursement for members of the State Lottery

5 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF6 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

9	(a) In this subtitle the following words have the meanings indicated.
10	(c) "Commission" means the State Lottery Commission.

12	(d) <u>A AS PROVIDED IN THE STATE BUDGET, A</u> member of the Commission:
13 14	(1) may [not] receive compensation <u>AS PAYMENT FOR ATTENDANCE AT</u> COMMISSION MEETINGS OR OTHER LOTTERY FUNCTIONS IN AN THE AMOUNT OF:
15 16	(I) <u>UP TO \$3,000</u> <i>\$125 PER MEETING ATTENDED, NOT TO EXCEED</i> <i>\$1,500</i> ANNUALLY FOR A COMMISSION MEMBER WHO IS NOT THE CHAIRMAN; AND
17 18	(II) <u>UP TO \$4,000 \$165 PER MEETING ATTENDED, NOT TO EXCEED</u> <u>\$2,000 ANNUALLY FOR THE COMMISSION CHAIRMAN;</u> [but] AND
19 20	(2) is entitled to reimbursement for reasonable expenses incurred in the performance of the duties as a member , as provided in the State budget .

21 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take 22 effect October 1, 1998.
